Support Hesburgh Hospital in rural Ecuador

Conquer a challenging cycling route of 500 miles in its first tour of Lake Michigan.

It's all about delivering quality health care for Ecuador's rural communities.

In 2014, Andean Health and Development (AHD) opened Hesburgh Hospital in Santo Domingo, Ecuador, This second hospital of AHD is designed to be a full-service, financially self-sustaining teaching hospital, with centers for clinical care, teaching and research, and soon, as a hub for telemedicine outreach to an expanding number of smaller clinics.

More than \$4 million has been raised to construct and equip Hesburgh Hospital.

Now, the AHCT wants to help launch the next 20 years for AHD with a campaign to raise \$1.2 million. Reaching this goal will keep us on track for achieving self-sustainability for Hesburgh Hospital and strengthening our model for providing quality care today and teaching the health care professionals of tomorrow.

Ultimately, AHD envisions that its successful model will be replicated in other parts of Ecuador and rural Latin America.
